



## **IREVA POLICY - SAFESPORT IMPLEMENTATION**

Adopted 11/20/2015

Beginning with the 2016 IREVA Junior Regional Championships, all rostered adults must be SafeSport-certified in order for the team to be accepted into the event. Any unrostered adult participating in any capacity at the event (including but not limited to Officials, work team, Tournament / Site Directors) must be SafeSport-certified in order to work / volunteer at the event.

Beginning with the 2016 IREVA HP program, all coaches/assistant coaches must be SafeSport-certified prior to participation in tryouts, camps or the HP tournament.

Beginning with the 2016/17 season, all Junior club coaches and assistant coaches must be SafeSport-certified prior to participation in camps, tryouts, practices, tournaments or other club activities. Waivers may be granted by the Juniors Director coinciding with IMPACT waivers for new coaches. It is highly recommended that all other adults associated with Junior clubs also become SafeSport-certified.

Beginning with the 2015/16 season, all IREVA BOD members and Officials must be SafeSport-certified.
